



PROJECT BRIEF

ISBVI and ISD Co-Campus Bat Mist-Net Survey

The Indiana School for the Blind and Visually Impaired and the Indiana School for the Deaf proposed a combined co-campus on the grounds of the former school, requiring clearing of trees in the time-of-year restriction window for the construction schedule. The 70-acre project site contained athletic fields throughout the site along with a paved trail system through the forested areas. BioSurvey group was contracted to complete a presence / absence bat survey for Endangered Species Act compliance, conducting 10 mist-net nights across the site. A total of 16 bats of two species were captured over the course of the survey, none of which were endangered or threatened. BioSurvey Group completed the surveys safely and efficiently and submitted a detailed report to both U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service as well as Indiana Department of Natural Resources within the scheduled time frame and budget.
